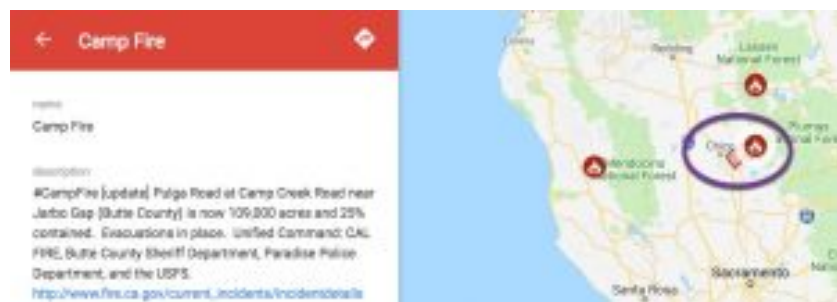


California Fire Donation Resources
